Public meeting on the stress tests for nuclear power plants organized by ENSREG and European Commission 17 January 2012, Brussels, Belgium

The first public meeting on the stress tests for nuclear power plants and the related peer review process will be held in Brussels on 17 January 2012.

The stress tests peer review programme adopted by ENSREG contains provisions on public engagement concerning the stress tests.
